### News from Councils.....

The LSM Church Committee met on April 30<sup>th</sup> to discuss the following:

- Gay Young has joined the Committee. There is still one vacancy.
- One letter was received about the church reordering – to which Simon had replied.
- Alan Green has offered specialist help.
- Stuart reviewed forthcoming services including Pentecost Praise, 6.00pm on June 9<sup>th</sup>.
- Jane's last service is on Sunday June 23<sup>rd</sup> followed by refreshments.
- Jane's Induction at Burton Bradstock is on July 18<sup>th</sup>. A coach will leave here at 5.00 pm
- The Civic Service is on Sunday July 14<sup>th</sup>.
- An Auction of Promises will be held on Saturday November 2<sup>nd</sup>.
- A Tea Dance in aid of Terekeka School will be held on the Masonic Hall in October
- Repairs to the listed wall behind the Parish Hall were quoted at £33K. Matter will be undertaken by the PCC.
- Cost of the Church quinquennial work is put at £10k. The Historic Churches Trust might help.
- Plans for the exterior lighting of the East Window are in abeyance. Scheme being rethought.
- A stand and money box for the votive candles could cost £300.
- A CCTV system separate from the A-V system will cost £800.
- Mark Lapper is taking over from Jack Haworth as Health and Safety Representative.
- The Pilgrimage to Lindisfarne is now full. Vacancies for Oberammergau next year.
